Myron Borys provides leadership to Edmonton Economic Development Corp. (EEDC) as the Vice-President of Economic Development. His team executes a cluster-based economic development strategy and manages the Edmonton Research Park with the goal of facilitating and promoting the development of a strong economic and tourism base in Greater Edmonton.

Myron's career spans 18 years of increasing management responsibility in the fields of technology, marketing, telecommunications and economic development. He has an extensive background in new technology management and commercialization that enables him to offer the community a balance of technical expertise and business development skills.

Myron joined EEDC in 2002 from TELUS where he spent 13 years building his leadership and technology skills. While at TELUS, Myron led the Consumer Internet Services team through its challenging start-up and high growth phase; managed the project to deploy \$10M of telecommunications infrastructure for the 2001 World Championships in Athletics; and most recently led the product management team for a \$2.1 billion portfolio of telecommunications products.

Myron holds a B.Sc. in Computer Engineering (U of M); an MSc in Electrical Engineering (U of A); and has been a member of APEGGA since 1988. He supplemented his technical background with an MBA in 1994 from U of A.

In his volunteer activities, Myron currently serves as President of the 2006 World Handball Foundation as well as co-chair of the tournament. He is also coach of an Edmonton Under-14 girls soccer team.
